This is one of the special events within the Girl Guiding year which takes place every year on the 22nd of February (usually during half term). World Thinking Day is when Rangers, Guides, Brownies and Rainbows everywhere remember each other and their commitment to Girl Guiding and Scouting, international friendship and understanding. It was first celebrated in 1927 and the date chosen marks the joint birthday of the Founder and the World Chief Guide, Lord and Lady Baden-Powell.
