On Tuesday 18th June, Year 5 will be visiting the National Space Centre, in Leicester. This is linked to our Science topic, 'Earth and Space'.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to learn more about the planets in our galaxy. The children will be taking part in the following activities: discovering what it is like in space; exploring the UK's largest domed planetarium, crammed full of space suits, rockets, satellites and meteorites; visiting the rocket centre and coming face to face with astronauts. The children will have a fantastic day that promises to be one to remember!

The cost of the trip is £23, which needs to be paid by Thursday 23rd May on school Gateway.

Details of the trip are below:

The date of our trip is Tuesday 18th June, 2024.

- We will leave school **promptly at 8:45am**, so please ensure all children **arrive before 8:30am**.
- We are due to depart the venue at 2:00pm, with a view to **arriving back at school in time for dismissal at 3:30pm**. If our journey home is delayed due to traffic, we will keep you updated via School Gateway.
- We are travelling by coach, if your child suffers with motion sickness, please can you let us know in advance - we will ensure we have sick bags, sit them towards the front of the coach and make any stops enroute if required, to make the journey as comfortable as possible.
- Every child will need a packed lunch. Please bring from home or order a sandwich option on the **School Food United app before Friday 14th June**.
- **Full school uniform should be worn by all pupils**, including sensible school shoes.
- **Payment must be made by Thursday 23rd May**
- **Children do not need any spending money.**
