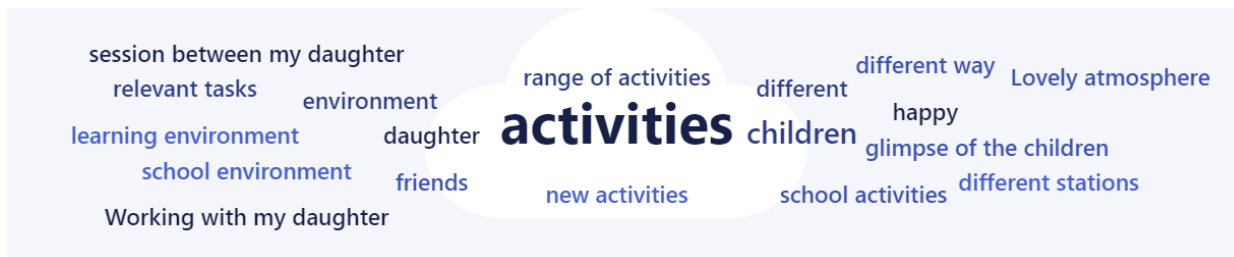




Nursery and Reception Parent Inspire Workshop – Early Learning Goals
