1. When using the Internet, in school, I will follow the SMART rules:



2. I will keep my username(s) and password(s) a secret and never attempt to log into any resource using another person's details.
3. I understand that I am responsible for any messages I send and that these may be monitored by the school.
4. I will not respond to rude or threatening messages, but I will tell a teacher immediately if I receive messages of this kind.
5. I understand that things that I download (such as images, music, video etc.) belong to someone, and I will only use these in my school work.
6. I will not play games (unless told to by my teacher) during lesson time.

I understand the above rules and agree to follow them. I understand that if I break the rules, my access to the Internet and school ICT may be stopped.
